Secutech Thailand returns today after three-year hiatus

Bangkok, 1 November 2023. The long-awaited trade fair for security and fire safety will open its doors from 1 to 3 November at the Bangkok International Trade & Exhibition Centre (BITEC), shining a spotlight on cutting-edge solutions for various sectors including manufacturing, smart cities, the commercial sector, transportation, and hospitality. Spanning 7,500 square meters of exhibition space, the show features over 200 exhibitors from Canada, China, India, Israel, Singapore, South Korea, Taiwan, Thailand, the United Arab Emirates, and the United States, facilitating opportunities to strengthen international cooperation and share the latest technology advancements.

This year's show carries immense significance, as it marks its first return since 2019 after being interrupted by the pandemic.
